Worked Example	Criteria	DPIA?
Hospital processing its patients' genetic and health data	4, 5, 7	Yes
Individual physician, other health care professional or lawyer, processing personal data from patients or clients	4, 7	No
Camera system monitoring driving behaviour, analysing videos to single out cars	3, 8	Yes
Company systematically monitoring employees' activities, work stations, internet activity etc	3, 7	Yes
Gathering public social media data for generating profiles	1, 4, 5, 6	Yes
Institution creating a national level credit rating or fraud database	1, 2, 4, 9	Yes
Archiving pseudonymised sensitive data on vulnerable data subjects of research projects or clinical trials	4, 7, 9	Yes
Online magazine using mailing list to send generic daily digest to subscribers	5	No
E-Commerce site displaying ads for vintage car parts involving limited profiling based on items viewed or purchased on its site	1	No
